




National Survey of Older Americans Act Participants

Program Quick Facts

- Title III of the Older American Act (OAA) encourages and assists state and local agencies in the development of comprehensive and coordinated in-home and community based long-term services for older adults.
- The National Survey of OAA Participants (NSOAAP) collects data on Title III programs. The results of this survey help ACL demonstrate to Congress how well programs achieve their legislative goals.

The 2017 NSOAAP data tells us that many individuals receiving case management, homemaker, and transportation services need help with **three or more Activities of Daily Living (ADLs)**, which is an indicator of possible nursing home placement were they not receiving OAA services.
